4. Academic Enhancement Committee minutes held on 24 May 2017

Members **RECEIVED AND NOTED** the unconfirmed minutes of Academic Enhancement Committee meeting held on 24 May 2017.

5. Higher Education & Research Act 2017

Members *RECEIVED AND NOTED* the Higher Education and Research Act 2017. The Act received Royal Assent on 22 April 2017.

It was noted that the Act had been discussed at AEC and that the relevant subsections were passed on to respective external groups for analysis and action.

Members deferred discussions of the Act until the relevant groups/committees have met to discuss the key issues as highlighted in the minutes of Academic Enhancement Committee on 24 May 2017 under minute 5.1.

It was noted that the TEF outcome would be known on 15 June 2017.

The SU Vice President raised students concerns about the raising of tuition fees. Members noted that fees currently rise in line with inflation.

Accelerated Degrees were to be discussed at PMG and then form discussions at School Boards and the Learning & Teaching Conference.

Future meeting

Members noted that the Act showed the recognition of diversity by being full embedded in the document.

The Act requires all new providers to work with experienced providers.

Members **RECEIVED** initial discussions and implications for groups, the strategy and stakeholders. It was agreed that the Act would be revisited once the groups have met.

6. Amended Terms of Reference for the Stakeholder Engagement Group

Members **RECEIVED AND APPROVED** the revised terms of reference for the Stakeholder Engagement Committee incorporating the Collaborative Partnership Steering Group. The group's responsibilities and membership closely align to the Stakeholder Engagement Committee, which led to the merger of both groups.

The group would ensure a consistent overview of stakeholders' engagement, coherent development and management of university partnerships.

7. University documents approval process

The University documents approval process was deferred until a future meeting.

8. University Institutional Returns

Members noted the following:

- The University Provider Profile was due to be submitted on 16 June 2017
- BGU is currently surveying the April DLHE leavers.
- The Data Team is preparing the HESA Student submission
- BGU is due to submit the first ILR return on 6 June 2016
