

She is president of Tearfund She has taught at Oxford University, King's College, London and is currently a member of the High table at Newnham College, Cambridge. Elaine has held visiting professorships across the world.

She has lectured all over the world and been involved in broadcasting for 25 years, most recently with the World Service and is currently writing for a Swedish newspaper as their Voice from the U.K. She has written eight books, hundreds of journal and newspaper articles and is working on a book: 'Scars Across Humanity.'





LIBRARY EXTENSION AND REFURBISHMENT NEARING COMPLETION

In February 2011, the Sibthorp Library at Bishop Grosseteste University College Lincoln celebrated its 125th birthday. To prepare the library for another century of use, a £2.5m extension and refurbishment project began in August 2011 with a view to creating a state-of-the-art resource at the heart of the BG campus.

The design for the library building project proposes a space which will be inviting, accessible, comfortable, flexible and future-proof. The designs include a large flexible study room for group work, several seminar rooms, a silent study space incorporating four individual silent study booths, a 24 hour access IT Suite, and lots of study spaces in and around the book shelves. It is the intention to also include a purpose-built facility for BG's extensive Children's Collection of children's books and classroom resources, in the style of a school library, and a specific room in which to house a comprehensive Lincolnshire Collection of local history books.




How to Find Us
