It's our 150th birthday!



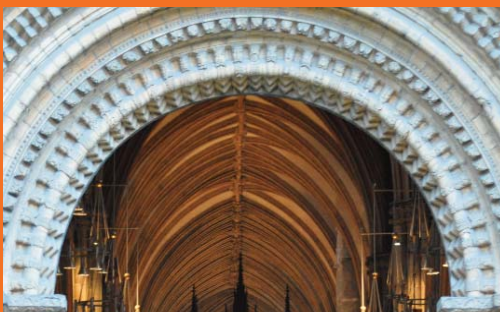

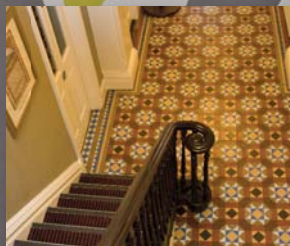



Lincoln Theological Society Lecture: Jesus and Genesis: Tales of Two Brothers



Lincoln Theological Society (LTS) starts its second season of lectures on Wednesday 14 March with a lecture by Trevor Dennis, entitled *Jesus and Genesis: tales of two brothers*. Jesus' parable of the two brothers, usually called The Prodigal Son, is full of references to the Genesis stories of Jacob and Esau, and Joseph and his brothers. His handling of these tales and especially his parables extraordinary punchline, raise very radical questions about any notions of the People of God. Trevor Dennis is a Hebrew Scholar who uses the original text for his work and arrives at some totally unfamiliar conclusions. LTS hold 3 lectures a year and are not attached to any religious denomination or organisation. Their aim is to hear respected and published theologians thinking aloud.

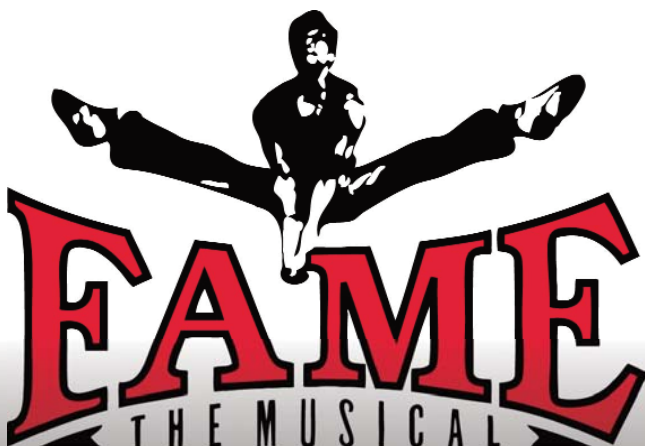

Our Library

LIBRARY EXTENSION AND REFURBISHMENT UNDER WAY

In February 2011, the Sibthorp Library at Bishop Grosseteste University College Lincoln celebrated its 125th birthday. To prepare the library for another century of use, a £2.5m extension and refurbishment project began in August 2011 with a view to creating a state-of-the-art resource at the heart of the BG campus.

The design for the library building project proposes a space which will be inviting, accessible, comfortable, flexible and future-proof. The designs include a large flexible study room for group work, several seminar rooms, a silent study space incorporating four individual silent study booths, a 24 hour access IT Suite, and lots of study spaces in and around the book shelves. It is the intention to also include a purpose-built facility for BG's extensive Children's Collection of children's books and classroom resources, in the style of a school library, and a specific room in which to house a comprehensive Lincolnshire Collection of local history books.

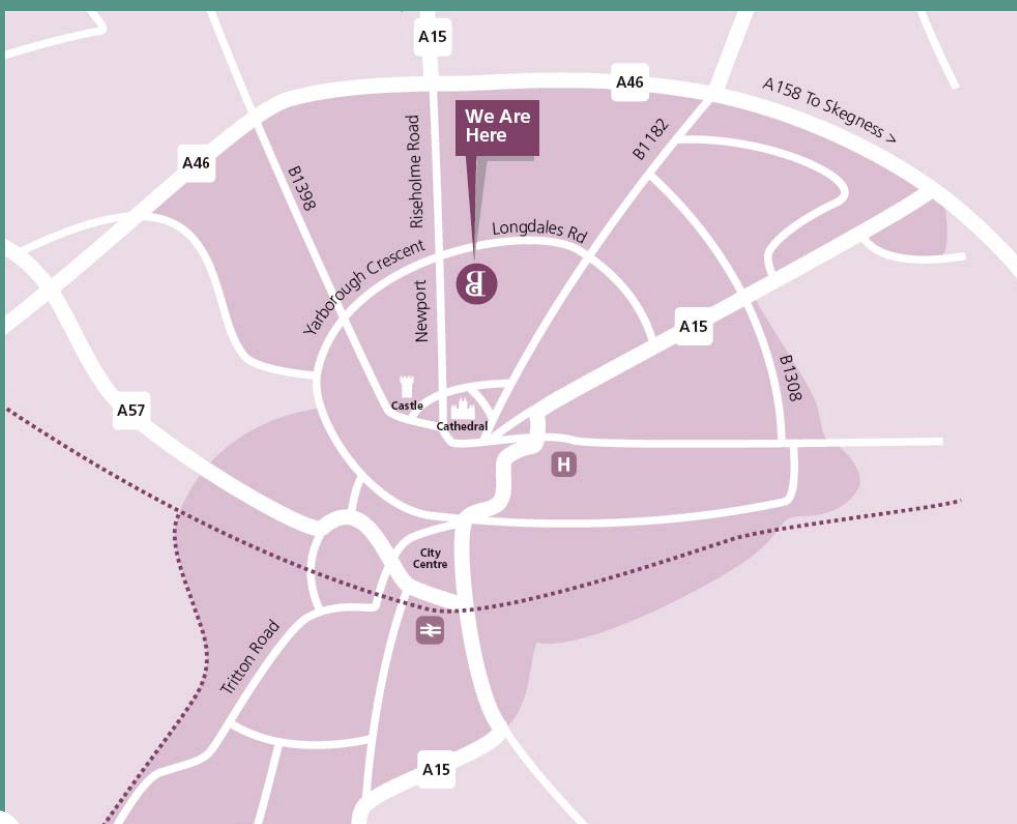
How to Find Us
