Our activities will include:

- Attendance at school and college led events.

In order to keep all staff and students safe, we will have to put additional measures in place in accordance with guidance. These include:

- Electronic Resources - We will be unable to give out physical resources, however these will be sent electronically post-session.
- Restrictions on campus - We will be unable to accommodate any large group visits on campus in the Autumn term, but will update you as guidance develops.
